Throughout the 1960s and '70s, RC became more dominant and, like many clubs, the FKMAC found itself moving to various flying sites. Today the club has found stability at its present flying site of 25-plus years, and it invites all forms of model aviation.

**Model aviation** and full-scale fliers alike have lost a legend. On October

12, 2017, District II AMA member Henry "Mr. Gee Bee" Haffke passed away. An avid water-skier, snow skier, and roller skater, Henry's real passion was aircraft, full scale and otherwise. Modelers benefited from Henry's love of Scale aircraft when he became a designer and product expert with the Coverite company.

Trips with his father to the Springfield, Massachusetts, airport, in Henry's youth led to his love of aviation throughout his life. In his teens, Henry started building model airplanes and he obtained his pilot's license at age 16. Henry's real love was designing, building, and flying competitive Scale models, including the Golden Era Gee Bees that he had watched flying at the Springfield airport.

Henry's designs were regularly published in national and international model aviation publications. He wrote and published *Gee Bee: the REAL Story of the Granville Brothers and Their Marvelous Airplanes*. More recently, Henry was honored for his life's work by the National Aeronautic Association (NAA) and inducted into the AMA Model Aviation Hall of Fame. Henry was respected by modelers and the full-scale community as the world's foremost authority on Gee Bee aircraft and their Granville brothers designers.
